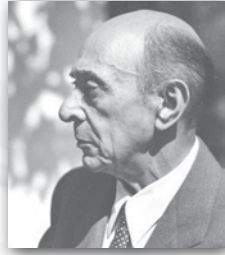


1 in 5 Ashkenazi Jews is a carrier for a Jewish genetic disease and may not know it.
